Project Info: The centre is located in pedestrian are of Hellersdorf. It services users are families from direct neighbourhood, which live in difficult economic circumstances and mostly have social problems. For the users of "Buntes Haus" the intercultural experience is important. We made the experience, which the volunteers enrich the offers of our facility with new, sometimes unconventional ideas. The work is structured in open irregular offers and weekly courses such as: reading club, dancing hour, common (international) cooking, offers in music, arts, sports, Users are Seite **1** von **3**



mostly kids from 0 - 10 years old and their families. We believe in the exchange of ideas and skills and we are aware that intercultural learning is one of the most valuable experiences in the development of the individual.

Volunteers: 1 patient and motivated volunteer required for organizing and facilitating social involvement and activities for parents and their children (ages can range from babies to young teenagers). Service users mostly live in the district which is surrounding project venue. Since not many parents speak other language than German and children also basic level at German language is necessary.

Activities may include: arts and crafts; organizing trips out; children's activities; "life skills" such as basic cookery; health promotion, health and nutrition, education, reading etc. Many of the children in the project are coming from foreign background.

Project Info: Anna Landsberger youth centre is mostly focused on programs for local youth, culture and learning processes. In this youth centre, local youth is coming and spending free time according to their own interests. They also implement initiatives for more quality spending of time and for improving facilities and services in this youth centre. Users of the Youth centre are youngsters in Age from 10 to 27. We implemented many projects in our district which is mostly populated with people and youth with economical difficulties. Our district is hosting refugees in refugees cams. There are 2 camps in surrounding of the Anna, each is hosting 500 people and 3 more internship accommodations from which each hosts 300 people. In this number it is a lot of English as well as Arabic speaking youngsters which had become target group of "Anna Landsberger" youth centre since they are our new neighbours. The youth centre "Anna Landsberger" lives from active doing of youngsters from district. That's why it becomes a place where they like to try out several things and blossom despite their individual differences. The service of EVS-volunteers will be a good combination especially now when we have more young neighbours who are in need of integration and regular culture/sub culture needs of youngsters.

Volunteers: 1 patient and motivated volunteer required for organizing and facilitating social, integration, artistic involvement and activities youngsters. Service users mostly live in the district which is surrounding project venue. Since there are "new" neighbours in our district knowledge of Arabic or German is appreciated.

Activities may include: arts and crafts; organizing trips out for summer schools; "life skills" such as basic cookery; health promotion, health and nutrition, education, German language, integration activities, urban art, singing, rap sessions, theatre, urban gardening etc. Many of the youngsters in the project are coming from foreign background.

After we are one association, it is also possible, and in fact we suggest, that beside the main field of work, you can also be particularly active in other two facilities. We strongly believe, that the special personal skills and interests can be used and you will be able to share them in own projects.
