Who:

- ➔ Applicant/Coordinating organization : Fédération des MJC de l'Aisne / Fédération des MJC de Picardie.
 - FR MJC is a regional NGO/Association that gather Youth Club in the northern part of France. These Youth Club are named « MJC » for « Maisons des Jeunes et de la Culture » (Trans. Houses for Youth and Culture). All the “MJC” are NGO/Association. “MJC” promote non-formal education. “MJC” are actively involved in the field of youth, culture, sports, active citizenship, fight against discrimination and much more.
 - MJC has a national “declaration of principles” which states that their aims are: To allow access for all to education and culture / To build a more inclusive society / to encourage sense of responsibility and citizenship practices / to promote the transfer of knowledge / to encourage cultural expressions and practices / to be open to all without discrimination / to be respectful of personal beliefs / to prohibit all ties with a political party, trade/labor union or a confessionion.
 - The fields of MJC is very broad. It can go to organization of sports activities, local entertainment, implementation of cultural events, international youth event, debates, local lobbying ...
 - “MJC” receive an agreement "youth & non-formal education" of the French Ministry of Youth and Sports.

What:

Main missions:

Target group: youngsters from 6 to 10yo
- ➔ Intervention during the school holidays (February/Spring/Summer) action linked with citizenship and non-formal education near the city Youth Center.
- ➔ Intervention in the city Youth Centers to promote international mobility

- ➔ Travel costs, individual support, organizational support: regarding Erasmus + Program funding rules
