About our Region and City...

Guadeloupe is an archipelago of over a dozen islands that combine to offer travelers a wealth of attractions from deserted beaches to soaring mountains. Guadeloupe's two main islands look like the wings of a butterfly and are joined together by just a couple of bridges and a mangrove swamp. Grande-Terre, the eastern of the two islands, has a string of beach towns that offer visitors marvelous stretches of sand to laze on and plenty of activities. Mountainous Basse-Terre, the western island, is home to the wonderful Parc National de la Guadeloupe, which is crowned by the spectacular La Soufrière volcano.



You will be located in the city of Le Moule, It is located on the northeast side of the island of Grande-Terre. Open to the Atlantic ocean, Le Moule was the first commercial port of Guadeloupe and you still can see the physical remains of this proud history, while hanging around the city.



You will also have the opportunity to meet locals, enjoy our main beach “*La plage de l'autre bord*” and visit the mangrove.

Accomodation....

You are going to be accommodated at L'hébergement " Le Centre d'hébergement du Moule", this venue has Fifteen equipped bungalows, who has from four to six beds. You will also find private access to the beach, a swimming pool, tennis courts ...and a great view of Le Moule and the Atlantic ocean.



The accommodation will provide sheets, pillows and towels for each person. **HOWEVER, YOU NEED TO BRING A TOWEL** It is therefore normal for you to bring your own soap, shampoo, toothpaste and brush, as well as any other products you use during your self-cleaning procedure. We offer you free Internet access and a lot of free space !



What to bring...

- Bring towels, slippers, shampoo, hair dryer.
- Men must bring a **swim brief** to have access to the swimming pool
