


WHERE?

Our program will take place in Cerreto Sannita, a small but charming town in the province of Benevento, Italy.

The accommodation is a monastery which is on the way to become a cultural and associational hub in our community promoting social work and inclusion. Rooms can typically host from 2 to 5 people and have all private bathrooms. The place has many workshop rooms and common areas where to work and play.

HOW?

Every activity will be explained and will be done in English.

Part of the project starts from leading the activities inside the monastery and complete outside in the town of Cerreto Sannita with the community. Therefore we invite you to consider the monastery a source of inspiration. We aim also at bringing impact of an intercultural dimension in our area.

During the preparation period each country will gather or produce photo and video documentation on the topics of migration affecting their communities.

Suggested topic which can be, of course, changed with other similar ones:

1. Estonia, ex-Russian stateless communities
2. Greece, Syrian refugees and island camps
3. Italy, sub-Saharan and Libian political refugees
4. Poland, Lithuanian communities or youth abroad after 2004
5. Romania, ROM culture or generations with parents abroad
6. Spain, North-African migrants
7. Turkey, Kurdish or Syrian communities

There will be other non-formal activities created during the exchange with photo, video-making, art workshops and more to be confirmed during the APV.

Improvement of your communication skills, knowledge of several countries' culture, and, obviously, a certificate proving your "MigrHub" experience.

So... how to get to Cerreto Sannita?

- 1) Napoli airport is definitely the first choice where to land! On 11th December we plan to have a private bus collecting all the groups at 17:00 at the airport and, if necessary, at the main train/bus station.
So pls search for a plane landing no later than 16:00.
- 2) Roma Fiumicino and Roma Ciampino airport are also possible choices but it can be a long travel as it takes up to 5 hours to reach the main Napoli station by bus and train. If this is your choice, please search for a plane landing no later than 12:00 in order to reach our private bus in Napoli.

Food, accommodation and project costs are fully covered and free.
 As for the travel, we can reimburse up to 100% (max) of the costs below:

Participants coming from Turkey will be reimbursed, instead, up to € 60 in total per person both for their medical insurance and visa costs.
