DESCRIPCIÓN DEL PROYECTO / PROJECT DESCRIPTION.	<p>Project Site:</p> <p>Caritas Sofia is looking for two long-term EVS volunteers for its daycare center for mothers in disadvantaged situation "Rojdestvo Hristovo". The volunteer is supposed to start their service at the beginning of February or March 2013 and stay for a year.</p> <p>The center was established some 12 years ago in order to financially and morally support women at risk. The priority group are women who raise their children on their own and the assistance provided to them is aimed at preventing the abandonment of their children in institutions. Besides them, there are mothers who have many children, adoptive mothers, mothers lacking support because of domestic violence, mothers with sick children, mothers with mental and physical disabilities and girls who have grown up in orphanages.</p> <p>The goal of the center is to empower women to cope on their own. It offers personalized social programs that deal with the specific problems of each individual. There are craft workshops where the women can work according to their interests. The workshops function as both work therapy and a source of some, albeit modest, additional income. The center also assists women in finding employment. It supports young women from institutions to transition into leading an independent life by providing temporary accommodation and work. The center works closely with the regional state administration, employment bureaus, and social services institutions.</p> <p>Throughout the years the center has helped more than 300 mothers in need. More than 60 of them achieved and maintain a stable material and social status, 6 of them were hired as full-time employees at the center itself. The center has 3 workshops - a ceramic, a textile, and a felt one, where the staff and the mothers work daily and make different dolls, ornaments, pottery, etc. to be sold at charity bazaars and for export. Tasks

Tasks: The volunteers will work closely with the staff and the other volunteers at the center. The staff is open to new suggestions and activities if the volunteers want to organize such. A list of activities volunteers can do: 70% of the time:

- work in the workshops
- spend time with the mothers at the center
- keep them company, encourage and motivate them in their efforts and pursuits
- interview new mothers coming to the center - meet and visit beneficiaries at their homes if necessary
- work with children who sometimes come to the center
- up-keep (cleaning, cooking, gardening, grocery shopping, laundry, etc.
- organize an activity of their own with the mothers
- maintenance of the web page of the center. 30% of the time:
- the volunteers will have the opportunity to meet and participate in other activities together with the rest of the volunteers at Caritas Sofia. Besides working with the disadvantaged mothers, he/she could work with refugee children at the Integration Center of the Bulgarian State Agency for Refugees, where Caritas has a volunteer tutoring project. Thus, the volunteer will be able to help more people and see social work from different angles.
- Promotional activities. The volunteers can be involved or organize different promotional activities about the project and EVS, organize an info-session about their country (about experiences, folklore & culinary specialties).
- The volunteer could also work with children from ethnic minorities, in locations where Caritas has organized such an activity

Criteria

Volunteer profile and recruitment process: The staff at the center is very dedicated, friendly and hard-working. They care very very much about their little community and they want to host a volunteer who is responsible, punctual, and has the need to help people in vulnerable situations. The center has hosted a number of volunteers so far and they are looking for someone motivated and caring in order to create a positive, satisfactory, and mutually-beneficial relationship.

The volunteer needs to know English at an intermediate level in order to be able to communicate with the staff at Caritas Sofia. Previous voluntary experience and curiosity towards new places and cultures are a plus.

Additional information: The volunteers will be enrolled in a Bulgarian language course. The daycare center is not far from the Sofia city center by tram and

It is open every week day between 06.30 and 07.50 and again between 11.30 and 16.45. The children come here before and/or after school and we can offer them a lot of different activities both outdoor and indoor such as sports, role play, story telling, baking and creative activities.</p> <p>One month every year is dedicated to an international theme where we focus on the children's home countries and their cultural background.</p> <p>Our staff consists of 16 persons, but we also have students from Danish teacher-training colleges. Alkjærskolens SFO "SPIREN" is a multicultural institution with children of parents from 26 countries. At the moment we have children from Greenland, Australia,</p>

	<p>USA and Thailand among others. Thus we already have a lot of focus on cultural differences and cultural understanding, and we think an EVS'er can be an inspiration both for the children, the staff and the parents through the sharing of his or her culture. Ringkøbing is a town in Ringkøbing-Skjern municipality in Region Midtjylland on the west coast of the Jutland peninsula in west Denmark. The town has a population of approximately 10.000. But every day during the year the town attracts many happy and shopping-minded guests spending their holiday nearby or in the holiday area by the North Sea which lays only 8 kilometres from Ringkøbing</p> <p>Tasks</p> <p>Through a stay at Alkjærskolens after-care "Spiren" the volunteer vil get a general insight into the education/ learning theories of a typical Danish institution and school. Furthermore he/she will get specific knowledge of educational activities such as sports, outdoor activities, art and creative activities e.t.c. The volunteer will be expected to take part in our daily life and the existing activities and traditions of the institution, but he/she will also have the opportunity to contribute with new projects and activities. We would also like the volunteer to share his/her country's traditions with the children and thus give them an insight in another culture. L'Arche got the project and would welcome volunteer in November 2013 for one year.</p> <p>This project is one of the permanent activities of The Association for Assistance to adult people with Learning Disabilities – l'Arche (Barka). Right now, Barka has already one EVS assistant from Turkey and it has open call to welcome another one. Barka is a member of international L'Arche community founded by Jean Vanier (http://www.larche.org/)</p> <p>We would like to offer young volunteers with less opportunities the possibility of developing their social sense, their sense of responsibility, encountering others (through work and leisure) from different European cultures and various social environments. We try to encourage dialogue among these young people and reflection on diversity. In this context we try to promote the same possibilities for people with learning disabilities (the right to work, accommodation, medical care...).</p> <p>By welcoming young volunteers from abroad Barka supports and encourages integration of people with learning disabilities into a wider society, promotes inter-cultural dialogue and cooperation and gives a chance to young people without formal education to get to know people with learning disabilities and the richness / gifts that they represent with their »different culture« and so enable them to acquire new experience and new knowledge.</p> <p>Tasks</p> <p>Volunteer's main task is participation in helping and accompanying persons with learning disabilities in our house where they live or during their work in our workshops. Role of volunteers is that with their presence they enrich the daily life and work of people with learning disabilities: 1. Assistance in the house presents help in the morning to wake them up and in the evening help them to go to bed; preparing meals together, cooking, do weekly shopping for the household and necessary cleaning of the rooms, kithcen, etc.; accompanying them in sports activities, playing games, social activities (welcoming visitors, going for a visit or a trip,...). Long-term volunteers are also invited to help with hygiene needs of people with learning disabilities. Volunteers are also invited to the celebrations, events (holidays, Christmas, pilgrimage...) that are prepared regularly in our association. They also take part in weekly meeting for assistants and once a month they can participate in trainings that are given by psychologist or psychiatrist. Assistants will also</p>
