KSA:K's mission is to contribute to the accreditation of the contemporary art practices in the Republic of Moldova by the encouragement of the new forms of artistic and cultural expression that would reflect the dynamics of the social, political and economical transformations of the country. The centre focuses on the integration of the local practices in the international cultural circuit. KSA:K is encouraging the new means of artistic expression and usage of new mediums, which we complement with adequate critical theories.</p> <p>KSA:K Center is located right in the center of Chisinau. It has an equipped space for film&video production, room for presentations and space used as a residency for artists. KSA:K office is open for the public access, it also opens for public the Moldovan artists' archive and library. For events that provide a broader audience, such as seminars, conferences and workshops we have established partnership with State University and Art Academy where we use big auditoriums involving students in our events. We also organize workshops and exhibitions in one of the oldest and the most significant buildings of Chisinau – Zemstvei Museum.</p> <p>Our main activities are: organization of exhibitions, interdisciplinary seminars, conferences, workshops, artists' presentations, artists exchange programs/residencies, publications of art catalogues, magazines and books, elaboration and implementation of interdisciplinary programs and courses; film, video and TV production; library, archive and videoteque development and maintenance.</p> <p>The direct target group of the KSA:K public program is the young generation of artists and students, with which we aim to stimulate critical attitude and civic responsibility.</p> <p>We are in direct contact with students, artists, teachers and professionals from art associations and large public with the aim of educating and promoting lasting relations between professionals and "non-professionals", artists and large public from Moldova. Three principles lie at the basis of the daily activity: Personality, Solidarity and Subsidiarity.</p> <p>Today, Caritas Moldova carries out its activity on the territory of Moldova through 11 branches (Caritas offices in Parishes) and a National Bureau located in Chisinau. Implemented activities on the entire territory of Moldova including Transdnistria (5 Parishes) are integral part of the 2012-2016 Strategic plan. The main directions of activity for Caritas Moldova, as described in the given plan, focus on the following areas:</p> <p>Directions of activity</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. For example the Education, Prevention and Youth strategic direction implements the following projects:

- 4 daily community centres for children in urban areas Balti, Ribnita, Bender/Tighina and urban area Rashkov, Kamenka region; A daily and placement centre for children 7-13 years old in Tiraspol with a capacity of 55 daily care, and 25 night care; 2 pre-school educational centres in villages where is no pre-school education, in Stircea/Glodeni, Sloboda Rashkov/Kamenka; A resource Centre for disable children in Singerei.
- Another 3 projects are on the way of being implemented, an education program for Child suicide prevention, Parish social Ministry, and empowering the Youth volunteers network.

Tasks

The volunteer's task could be different depending on ability and willingness to engage. This depends on region and project he/she is willing to be involved. Caritas Moldova has several projects with many tasks, but the volunteer can choose. For example:

This will allow the children to continue to develop as musicians both individually and as part of a larger orchestra/ensemble long into the future.

ABOUT THE PROJECT

Tepebasi Municipality (hosting organization) is realizing an international symposium each year. International Terra Cotta Symposium is organized to keep alive the terra cotta tradition in city (both traditional and industrial). Before foundation of Turkish Republic, the tile and brick were imported from abroad so as to establish import substitution policy; Eskisehir was chosen to establish first tile and brick factories to provide the supply of the country. The city was chosen due to the fact that its resources of terra cotta and traditional terra cotta production. Today to keep this tradition alive we organize series of event during the International Terra Cotta Symposium. The first one is, the artistic dimension, 5 National and 5 International artists are welcome and during 16 days they are expected to create an artistic sculpture that is going to be exhibited in outdoor areas of the city. Approximately 50-60 assistant students are helping these artists to curve, form and fire the terra cotta sculptures. The second part of the events is social events; there are exhibitions, concerts and contests that take every day. The last one is scientific events, scholars (national and international) present their proceedings in 2 days and these proceedings are gathered in a book to serve for scientific and industrial resources/purposes.
