As such, it is the nucleus from which the society grew into its modern-day form. The Institute communicates a wealth of information about "foreign" cultures as well as developing and maintaining contacts in numerous other countries.</p> <p>The main element supporting this work are the thirty bilateral country circles each run by honorary officials. Thanks to their workshops, talks, forums, concerts and exhibitions, they facilitate encounters and convey knowledge about life in other countries in Europe and throughout the world. Native Dortmundians and members of the ethnic communities are actively committed here.</p> <p>The individual volunteer would support the leader of the country circle in the planning and organising of intercultural events. Events which would convey information and demonstrate just how valuable the diversity of cultures is. At the same time, the volunteers would be expected to implement their own project focused on the concept of "We in Europe". By interacting with the country circle leaders, citizens, migrants and guests, they would convey a new form of voluntary commitment within the sphere of cultural exchange and help bring the young people of Europe closer together. One result would be cultural input for both the Foreign Institute and the local community.</p> <p>The Institute pursues public-benefit non-profit-making aims - and that applies to voluntary work as well. It pursues aims which are for the good of the community but these aims and activities do not replace a part-time or full-time job.</p> <p>Within the framework of their country circle involvement, the volunteers will be able to gather practical knowledge and intercultural experience</p>

	<p>with German society and other ways of life. She will learn how to prepare and present slideshows, discussion forums, talks, readings, country theme weeks, dances and musical soirées.</p> <p>Thanks to ongoing supervision via a full-time colleague at the Institute, all the tasks and learning experiences can be adapted to the volunteer's individual needs and wants. The exact level of work can be agreed in consultation with the Tutor.</p> <p>Tasks</p> <p>Main work: public relation for honorary country circles, Work with bilateral honorary country circles. They organise discussions , exhibitions, meetings, seminars with people form the both countries. Many possibilties to realise own ideas and projects. Then:Volunteers will assist the country circle leaders with the preparation of evening programmes, exhibitions, concerts, museum evenings, country and/or cultural weeks (based on China or the Baltic or Czechia, for instance), and, not least, the International Christmas Festival. Then: Organising an own project on the theme of "We In Europe" Examples here might be: carrying out a simple practical project; giving a talk about the situation in their native country; the organisation of reading evenings; writing articles for the AG NRW magazine; planning and implementing EVS info events; meetings with German and ethic minority school students et cetera, the aim being for the volunteers to develop and express their own ideas on the theme of "learning from one another".</p> <p>Criteria</p> <p>age over 20. Main point: We need a person who has big interest in media work/journalism and intercultural exchange. Very useful are german language skills But not precondition. Maybe experience in projects, exchange or else, because of the different working Open, friendly, teamworker. DESCRIPCIÓN DEL PROYECTO / PROJECT DESCRIPTION.	<p>Proposed activities for EVS volunteers</p> <p>*****</p> <p>The presence of the volunteer will help to enhance the dynamization of projects related to Youth Information at the CIDJ and will help to promote the richness of an intercultural approach.</p> <p>His/her learnings opportunities will be multiple. Development of competences in techniques related to interviewing young and adult public will be possible. He will also get the chance to develop his knowledge on tools of information, mainly numerical ones. Activities centered on numerical/multimedia development are sincerely appreciated. He will also be able to emphasize his capacities of communication in foreign language but so as cultural expression. With</p>

the public and within the organization, he will have the opportunity to develop his/her capacity of initiative and social and civic competences. According to his/her centers of interest, motivations and its personal project, other opportunities will certainly be considered and developed.

The activities to which the volunteer will participate can be divided into three part:

A phase of adaptation/training during which the volunteer the CIDJ, its missions, services, Youth Information network, institutional partners (meeting of presentation with the team) will be presented to the volunteer. He will also get to know the tools used to inform the public. Lastly, the volunteer will be able if it wishes it to develop his computers skills. This phase will also be the best one to start the language classes. Lastly, this moment will enable concertation to get to know the volunteer's ideas and motivations in order to redefine and adapt the project. He will have the opportunity to start preparing his own project.

Activities in collaboration with the team of the CIDJ: In collaboration with the person in charge of activities, the volunteer will have to enhance activities related to European awareness:

- collective information session (preparation to a departure abroad)
- individual session about european mobility supported by a professional Youth adviser
- numerical tools creation (blog, newsletter, powerpoint, quizz..) and Youth information tools (leaflets, flyers...)
- basic administrative tasks (answering mails...)
- According to these linguistic abilities, he could be a support to the creation and organization of workshops on various subjects (linguistic workshops, discovering of countries...)
- He can also help in the organization and participation of thematic events at CIDJ and with its partners
- .-Lastly, he will collaborate to the search and writing of information on the European countries or mobility to France.

Certain tasks will proceed in partnership with the youth counsellors at

	<p>CIDJ. He could observe interviews with young people, visit other structures of the youth information network. He will also take part in times of concertation and formation "information workshops of Thursday".</p> <p>Activities of the common regional project :</p> <p>The volunteer will be part of a team of volunteers that will meet once a week in order to enhance the dynamization of projects related to Youth Information on a regional level. They will develop common tools, will participate together to events of each hosting project and their partners in the region Ile-de-France.</p> <p>Any initiative or personal idea will be appreciated. As a conclusion, everything that is done will be under discussion and an evaluation will take place. b) Computer programs (35%). One of the main activities of the Volunteers is to take active part in the realization of Non-profit making Educational, Sports and Cultural programs and Presentations (e.g. a cultural Web Site about an Aegean Island, a web site about program "Youth" or about Young people's problems, etc. A very important aim for us is to give them the opportunity to come closer to New Technologies, learn and develop creative projects through practical and theoretical exchange of knowledge and feel free to express themselves, and gain knowledge that will help them for all their life. DESCRIPCIÓN DEL PROYECTO / PROJECT DESCRIPTION.	<p>Charity Centre for Refugees (CCR) was created on the initiative of some volunteers with the support of UNHCR Branch Office in the Republic of Moldova in October 1999. The Centre is a non-political, non-governmental and non-profit organisation. CCR's main objectives are: to provide cultural, moral and material assistance to refugees and asylum seekers in the Republic of Moldova as well as to help them integrating into the Moldovan society.</p> <p>CCR's main activities are services to refugees and asylum seekers in the Republic of Moldova, so that they could come and discuss their common interests and problems, participate in different events, meetings, seminars, etc; CCR organises entertaining activities for refugees and asylum seekers and their children like the International Women's Day, the International Children's Day, Refugee Day, New Year party, Christmas, the 50th Anniversary of UNHCR, birthdays of</p>

refugees; CCR hosts the general meetings of the Representative of UNHCR Branch Office in the Republic of Moldova with refugees and asylum seekers in the presence of other local and international entities; CCR carries out ecological activities with the participation of refugees and asylum seekers; CCR provides Romanian, Russian and English language classes to refugees and asylum seekers and their children; CCR provides refugee children with a room equipped with furniture and toys; CCR organizes excursions for refugee children and their mothers on the territory of Chisinau city (to museums, zoo, etc.).

During EVS project volunteer will work mostly with his supervisor - program coordinator, in order to plan and organise activities for and with beneficiaries from the Centre, also with teacher - volunteer's role will be to help in organising the activities with children

Tasks

Following the aims and objectives of our work the volunteer will be involved in various activities according to his/her interests and preferences and needs of the organisation. Working in our organisation on the mentioned tasks, the volunteer will be able to gain and skills and knowledge in the areas such as organisation, preparation and implementation of activities for refugees, communication skills and preparation of initiatives and campaigns. Typical working day of the volunteer could consist of following activities: - Education 20%: language classes - computer courses - study help for the school children - general social orientation subjects; volunteer is never alone in front of a group and there is always a support person. - Recreation 65%: music - pottery- sports - events - activities for specific target groups (children, women, men, etc) - library & internet; - Individual assistance 15%: every worker has a close contact with a certain number of refugees. Volunteer also interacts with refugees and there is always a support person to assist volunteer. The role of every volunteer is to help in many areas, so any volunteer can find satisfaction. During the weekly programs for refugees, we need people for leading the music, telling a story, playing a clown or drama, keep order or practical things like putting up the sound system, give out packages, helping us to organize activities in the State Reception Centre for Refugees and Asylum Seekers and etc. At the CCR we can use help for teaching the children, administrative work, cleaning, cooking (which we do together), playing with the children and talking or listening to any person who drops in. We also sort clothes and give these to the families when we visit them or make food packages. For this we need some good hands. The volunteer tasks will be revised upon volunteer arrival according to the current activities of the organization and motivation and abilities of the volunteer. Volunteer works 5 days per week in the CCR and 1 day per week, on Saturday- in the Shelter for asylum seekers coordinated by CCR. CCR shift starts at 10:00 a.m. and till 17 p.m. Shelter for asylum seekers shift is from 13 p.m. till 15 p.m. In case if there is some special event organized by the centre volunteer can stay longer and

	<p>work in the evenings upon his/her will. Volunteer is provided with work place, where</p> <p>Criteria</p> <p>The main recruitment criterion for the project Charity Centre for Refugees is flexibility, ability to work in multicultural environment and work individually. Volunteer should be open for cultural diversity and express tolerance towards cultural differences, because in our centre we work in a multicultural environment and we receive visitors of different national origins. We especially welcome young people who are interested in human rights, issues of refugees and asylum seekers and enthusiastic about community service development, Charity Centre for Refugees is a non-political organization, it does not stand for or support any political party of Moldova and is not involved in any political campaigns. That is why we expect the EVS volunteer to respect our internal policy and to be politically neutral and to avoid participation in any political actions or strikes in Moldova. Although CCR has a multinational team, speaking different languages, the working languages are mostly Russian and English. That is why we encourage volunteers to study the Russian language in order to easily communicate with staff members and beneficiaries</p>
