ABOUT THE PROJECT

Creativity and entrepreneurship are the characteristics of the youngsters. Because the youth is a period when the vision is shaped for the future, the right information is turned into hope. In this youth exchange, Journalism and newspaper culture which is one of the media tools frequently used today to encourage the creativity and entrepreneurship of the youngsters, will enable the youth to examine, ask questions, do the research, present new products and to implement their ideas. The aim of the project is to help the youngsters to reveal their enterprising and creativity spirit in journalism field, by getting to know their individual skills and interests and giving them chances to try themselves in the fields of scientific, social, artistic, cultural, mental, psychological and hand skills. During this project, all the participants will learn about the phases of preparing a newspaper and the important points of releasing a remarkable newspaper and the media organs. The participants will become conscious about the necessity of active citizenship and being up to date.

OBJECTIVES

- 1- To encourage the entrepreneurialships of the youth by giving them active roles.
- 2- To develop the research and questioning skills and the critical thinking of the youngsters.
- 3- To let the youngsters have experience in how a newspaper is planned and presented.
- 4- To raise awareness in the young about following agenda events.
- 5- To let the young participate in the group works, be able to organize and increase self-confidence.
- 6- To increase the cooperation and communication among the organizations working in the field of youth in Europe, the youth workers and the young.
- 7- To exchange ideas about how to design cooperation activities among the newspapers

The Youth Exchange will be held in a summer house, surrounded by green forests, located close to the Centre of Cēsis.

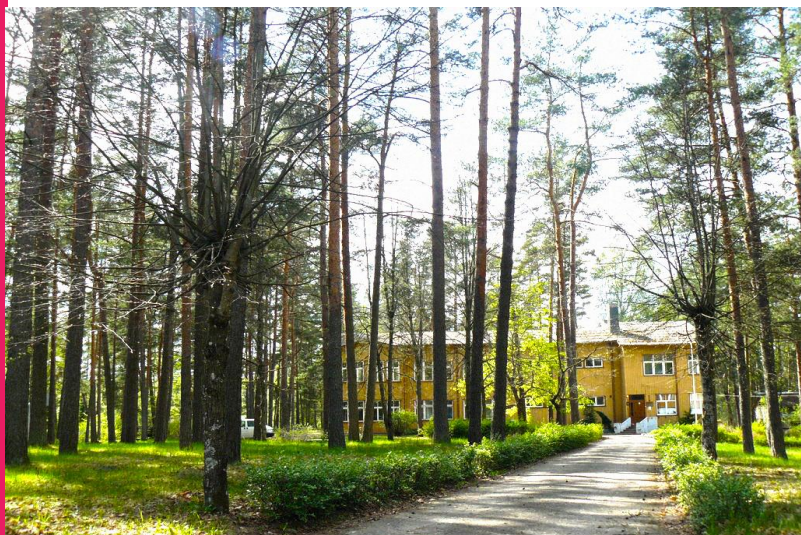
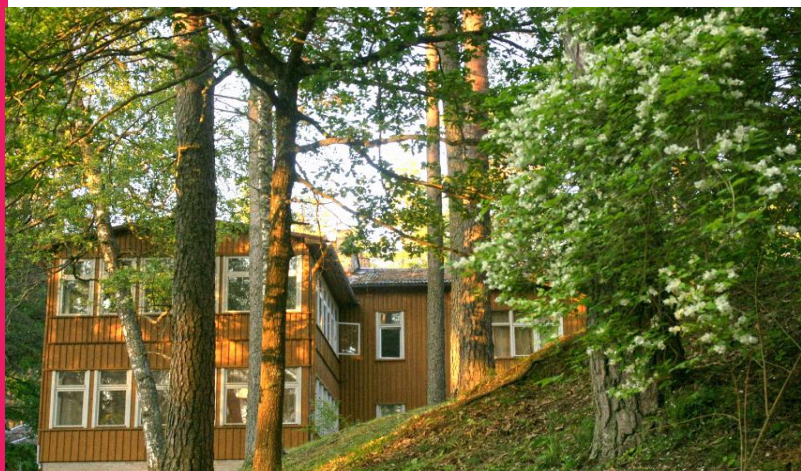
1. IF YOU ARRIVE BY PLANE

From the Riga International Airport, you have to take bus no 22. to the Centre of the city. The ticket per 1 ride costs 1.15 Eur and you can buy it in the kiosk "NARVESEN", that is next to the airport.. **In the Center you have to get out in the stop called "Autoosta" (Bus station)**, the stop is located next to the shopping Centre STOCKMANN.

2. IN THE CENTRE go to the Riga Central Train Station and take a train to Cēsis. The schedules can be found here:

The train ticket doesn't cost more than 5Eur. From there youll be taken by car.



WHAT TO PREPARE FOR THE YOUTH EXCHANGE

Each national team/participant has to:

1. Fill in the application form (all participants). The link will be posted in the Facebook group.
2. Prepare a short presentation about the Country (culture, traditions etc.)
3. Prepare some energizers/ team building games.
4. Bring some national foods and drinks for the intercultural evening
5. Post photos from the preparation phase in the Facebook group
6. There will be more information given during the Advance Planning Visit in May

OTHER IMPORTANT INFORMATION

1. In accordance with the ERASMUS+ rules and regulations, we expect you to participate the full activity
2. Arriving later and departing earlier is not an option
3. Consult the organizer on your travel plan in order to support you with being eligible for reimbursement
4. **We ask you to keep ALL your tickets, boarding passes and invoices (originals).** Only if you have the travel tickets, boarding passes and invoices, we are able to reimburse your travel costs
5. Insurance is not provided and will not be reimbursed by the organizers.
 - All participants are **obligated** to purchase private travel insurance.
 - **All EU residents should obtain European Health Insurance Cards (EHIC) before the exchange. This is obligatory for your safety and health!**
6. During our programme, in order to share delicacies and stories from our countries, we are going to use the coffee breaks of our programme to share with each other something from our homes. Every country is going to use the time of each coffee break to share with the others part of their culture. For this, we ask you to bring something from your country that can be served next to a cup of coffee or tea. Additionally, you can have with you flyers or anything else you think can share with the rest of the participants part of where you are coming from.

WHAT TO BRING?

- Clothes suitable for weather conditions in Latvia and personal hygiene items.
- **Please bring one computer per national team.**
- Any medication you think you will need during your stay.
