Our school is a public general and vocational agricultural high school. We are located in the suburban area of Albi (60,000 inhabitants) 45 minutes from Toulouse (capital of the Occitanie region) by car, 1 hour by train and close to an important shopping center. We have 550 pupils and students (15 - 22 years old) for 60 teachers and 20 non-teaching staff. We offer general scientific, technological and professional training in the following areas fields of water, landscape, horticulture and agriculture. We also have higher education (BTS and licence) as well as adult education.

The students mainly come from rural areas. They come from the region and stay the week at the high school (boarding school).

Activities carried out by the volunteer

Several activities are offered to young volunteers in the school:

- **Animation activities and student projects:** Volunteers can propose new activities or join existing projects (radio club, languages, environment, theatre, cultural or sports activities, intercultural evenings...). The projects are discussed and validated beforehand by the socio-cultural education teachers who are in charge of these projects, the students' association and the life of the homes. The number of projects in which the volunteers are involved corresponds to the time available in their timetable.
- **International cooperation:** CES volunteers are involved in accompanying young people with an international mobility project (looking for an internship, a voluntary project, putting together funding applications, linguistic and cultural preparation). Depending on their expectations, we can also involve them in setting up and following up ESC solidarity projects, Erasmus +, youth exchanges, and education for citizenship and international solidarity projects.
- **European week :** The volunteers are the driving force behind and coordinate an intercultural season on Europe in the broadest sense every spring in the school. Their role consists in building and participating in the animation of a programme aiming at making their country and European values better known through different activities (artist in residence, tales, concerts, exhibitions, conferences, films...). - **Linguistic support activity in spanish:** the role of the volunteers is to respond to the specific needs of the students and to encourage the practice of languages. They provide support adapted to their skills (languages, methodology, etc.). This activity is based on a voluntary approach by the young people. This activity (study only or specific slots) is included in the programme of the young people every evening after school. They will be in contact with the teachers, CPE and educational assistants of the school.

Hosting conditions

- **International transport:** Transport tickets and visa fees for Turkan will be paid by the sending organisation or the beneficiary and reimbursed by the host organisation the month following the arrival of the volunteers in September 2021.
- **Local transport:** The host organisation will provide a bicycle (long term rental service "CYCLO" from the Albi town hall) for the 10 months as well as a public transport pass to access the urban transport network which serves the campus in particular.
- **Accommodation:** The host organisation provides a 3 rooms furnished flat with a kitchen and a bathroom on campus where the two ESCs will be sharing (which is convenient for them). Free wifi internet connection on the campus.
- **Catering:** The campus has a school restaurant where the ESCs can eat free of charge morning, noon and evening during the school term. During school holidays and weekends,

the basic allowance will be supplemented (+175 euros per month minimum) so that each volunteer can buy and prepare their own meals.

- **Remuneration:** Each volunteer will receive an average of 400 euros per month (automatic transfer to their account at the end of the month).
- **Insurance and safety conditions:** The hosted ESCs will be automatically insured through the programme provider (registration by the sending organisation) / The global civil liability insurance of the school staff will also protect the volunteers. At the activity site, safety conditions are those imposed on educational establishments hosting minors.
