



## Placement Description Landheim Tellkampfschule

### **(2) Organization description:**

The Landheim Tellkampfschule has existed as an extracurricular place of learning since 1929. On an area of 32,500 square meters, based very near to the forest, the Landheim wants to combine education with fun and offer young people a place for rest and slowing down, where creativity and imagination can be lived out in community. It has 75 beds and is booked at peak times for around 8.000 overnight stays a year.

The Landheim is visited by school classes as well as children's and youth groups, who are offered projects in the areas of sustainability, nature and regionality.

The founder of the Landheim Tellkampfschule is a non-profit association whose desire it is to create awareness for a sustainable future.

According to its statutes, the association wants to raise awareness among the visitors of the Landheim for a sustainable future and, within the framework of its pedagogical concept in the sense of education for sustainable development, enable them to stand up for the respect of their natural livelihood.

### **(3) Description of the surrounding:**

The Landheim has extensive outdoor grounds with a soccer and volleyball field, a children's playground, a nature trail and an animal enclosure. For the warm season there is also a tent site for up to 250 people. Moreover, there is also a hall which can be used for various purposes (e.g. sports activities, cinema previews, theatre rehearsals or disco).

It is surrounded by fields and woods and is located on the outskirts of Springe (about 30.000 inhabitants), in the Hannover region.

Springe is well-connected to the S-Bahn network around Hannover. It takes 30 minutes to Hannover and 20 minutes to Hameln. Springe itself has a bus network and an on-demand bus, which also serves the Landheim. For trips to the city, the volunteers are provided with bikes by the Landschulheim and, if required, the costs for a monthly public transport pass are covered by the coordinating organization VIA e.V.
