Project summary

Our project "Let's build our own metaverse" will take in Murzasichle - one of the most picturesque regions in southern Poland.

We will host 48 youngsters 18-27yo from the following countries:

Greece, Italy, Romania, Spain, Lithuania and Poland.

By conducting our project we would like to increase youth's awareness and understanding of risks and threats, as well as benefits and opportunities related to the advances and broader adoption of metaverse, and other applications of blockchain technologies, and, in particular, non-fungible tokens (NFT). These technologies are widely considered to be a new more advanced version of the internet and are frequently referred to as Web 3.0. Web 3.0 technologies, according to many experts, will be to a greater extent controlled by individuals and not global tech behemoths (e.g.: Alphabet, Meta, Apple, Amazon) which control Web 2.0 applications. In 2021, when Facebook renamed itself to Meta, the popularity of metaverse implementations, as well as other applications of blockchain such as NFT (non-fungible tokens) grew significantly. Consequently, many experts and people familiar with those technologies started to ponder on the risks and benefits related to them. We invite you to our project young people that are familiar with blockchain technologies or would like to learn about them. In particular, we invite youngsters that are big fans of emerging metaverse technologies, IT students, but also youth that are more artistically focused and would like to use blockchain technologies to distribute its works independently from big corporations. .



Before making any travel plans arrangements please contact us to make sure that you choose the best option available!

You can also come 1-3 days before or after the Youth Exchange to visit Kraków, at your own expense.

Please make sure you do not lose your print or e-ticket with your names and dates on it (we need to reimburse travel costs).

Meeting point Kraków.
