

# Your Mission in Collège Rosa Parks Pouillon, Landes

## **SCHOOL MEDIA AND INTERCULTURALITY**

### **Context**

Rosa Parks Junior High School is a public school located in the rural town of Pouillon. There are 490 students, aged 10 to 15, divided into 18 divisions. Numerous projects are being implemented in the establishment around the medias, digital technology and citizenship, with the support of local partners such as the Francas des Landes, a national popular education movement. The school also hosts a Foyer Socio Educatif which supports various projects for the pupils, a staff association and a very active National Union for the development of sports at school.

### **Missions**

You will be entrusted with the following missions

- School medias (radio and gazette)
- European citizenship and mobility

Your mission within the school will encover the following task

- supporting pupils' work on school medias :
  - o taking part/hosting a web radio show,
  - o supporting the redaction of a school gazette on languages
- Promoting interculturality within the school and the local community
  - o encouraging European citizenship and mobility
  - o creating a web page/blog on the CES program and its impact on the school
  - o animating a « café des langues »

### **Means at your disposal**

You will receive support from the educational community and work in pair with teachers and other professionals within the school (teachers, vie scolaire, nurse...) . You will have access to all materials available to the staff, including a digital space on the school network, and you will be equiped with a laptop for the complete duration of your mission.

### **Mission duration and holidays**

The mission will extend from March 10th to June 20th, with a two weeks holiday period during which you may be offered, if so desired, the possibility to work in local partner associations.
