Foreign volunteering became one of the key-points of our development. Since 2018 we work with approx. 100 international volunteers from 19 countries!

Our organization operates in GDAŃSK (Poland), the capital of the Pomeranian Voivodeship.

It's located in the north, right by the Baltic sea.

With around 486.000 citizen, it's one of the largest Polish cities.

ABOUT THE KINDERGARTEN

Kindergarten No. 41 is located in Gdańsk. Kindergarten is attended by 100 children aged 3 to 6, including 18 children of other nationalities (from Ukraine, Belarus and Russia). The tasks of the kindergarten include: supporting the child's multidirectional activity by organizing conditions conducive to acquiring experience in the physical, emotional, social and cognitive area of his development.

Kindergarten creates conditions that allow children to develop freely, play and rest in a sense of security, strengthening the child's sense of value, individuality, originality and the need to create personal relationships and participation in a group, creating situations conducive to the development of habits and behaviors leading to independence, taking care of health, mobility and safety and taking care of mental health, stimulating the development of sensitivity and enabling learning about values and standards relating to the natural environment.

Kindergarten No. 86 in Gdańsk blends tradition with modernity. As the first facility in the city, we have an Art Studio that fosters creativity and passion in young children. We combine proven educational methods with the latest technologies – each classroom is equipped with Samsung FLIP interactive boards, supporting innovative learning approaches. We create a friendly and inspiring environment where children can develop their talents and interests. With over two years of experience hosting international volunteers, we enrich our daily activities with fresh perspectives and new inspirations.

Volunteer tasks at Kindergarten No. 86 in Gdańsk:

- Assisting teachers with daily activities in the classroom.
- Playing with children to support their development and creativity.
- Teaching simple words in English and the volunteer's native language through games, songs, and interactive activities.
- Participating in outings and trips, helping with child supervision and organizing activities outside the kindergarten.

Our volunteers have full freedom to organize activities based on their interests and skills (always in agreement with the teachers). Additionally, we provide delicious meals, ensuring that each day at our kindergarten is filled not only with joy but also with tasty food!

ABOUT THE KINDERGARTEN

Our kindergarten is a friendly educational institution located in Gdańsk, in the Przymorze district. We accept children aged 3-5, providing them with a safe and inspiring environment for learning, play, and overall development. The kindergarten has excellent facilities, including spacious, well-lit classrooms equipped with toys and teaching aids, interactive boards, a large gym, a speech therapy and therapeutic office, a sensory integration therapy room, and a kitchen. Behind the building, there is a playground with ample space for physical activities.

Volunteers will play an important role in the daily life of the kindergarten, supporting teachers and engaging children in various educational and cultural activities:

- Assisting the English-speaking teacher or introducing children to another foreign language.
- Participating in initiatives with our partners (schools, kindergartens, libraries).
- Introducing children to the culture, language, and traditions of the volunteer's country (stories, songs, games, simple workshops, teaching basic phrases in their language through play).
- Assisting teachers in organizing educational activities, play, and preparing teaching materials.
- Helping organize kindergarten events such as festivals, themed days, or performances, and assisting with decorations and materials.



ABOUT THE KINDERGARTEN

Kindergarten No. 8 is in Gdańsk and cares for 70 children aged 3–6. Our team includes 8 teachers and 9 support staff. We believe learning through nature helps children explore the world, discover colors, and develop their senses in a natural and joyful way.

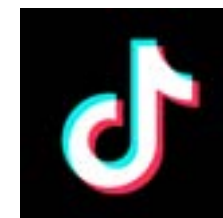
