PIYA implements the European Union's decisions, Council of Europe, and the United Nations in youth. The Association also maintains its activities by considering universal sensitivities, global principles, and principles in human rights, participation, and environmental issues.

Pi Youth Association's target group contains all individuals and youth workers between the ages of 15-30 living in Türkiye. From the target group, women, refugees, and disabled people have priority. In addition to carrying out activities to support young's personal development, Pi Youth Association also works on youth rights to solve the problems experienced by young people in our country. Pi Youth Association also determines its medium and long-term strategies according to the European Youth Strategy Document and the current youth situation in our country. Since 2016, Pi Youth Association has published its annual activities and balance sheets on its website by the principles of transparency and accountability. It is also a signatory of the donor rights declaration.

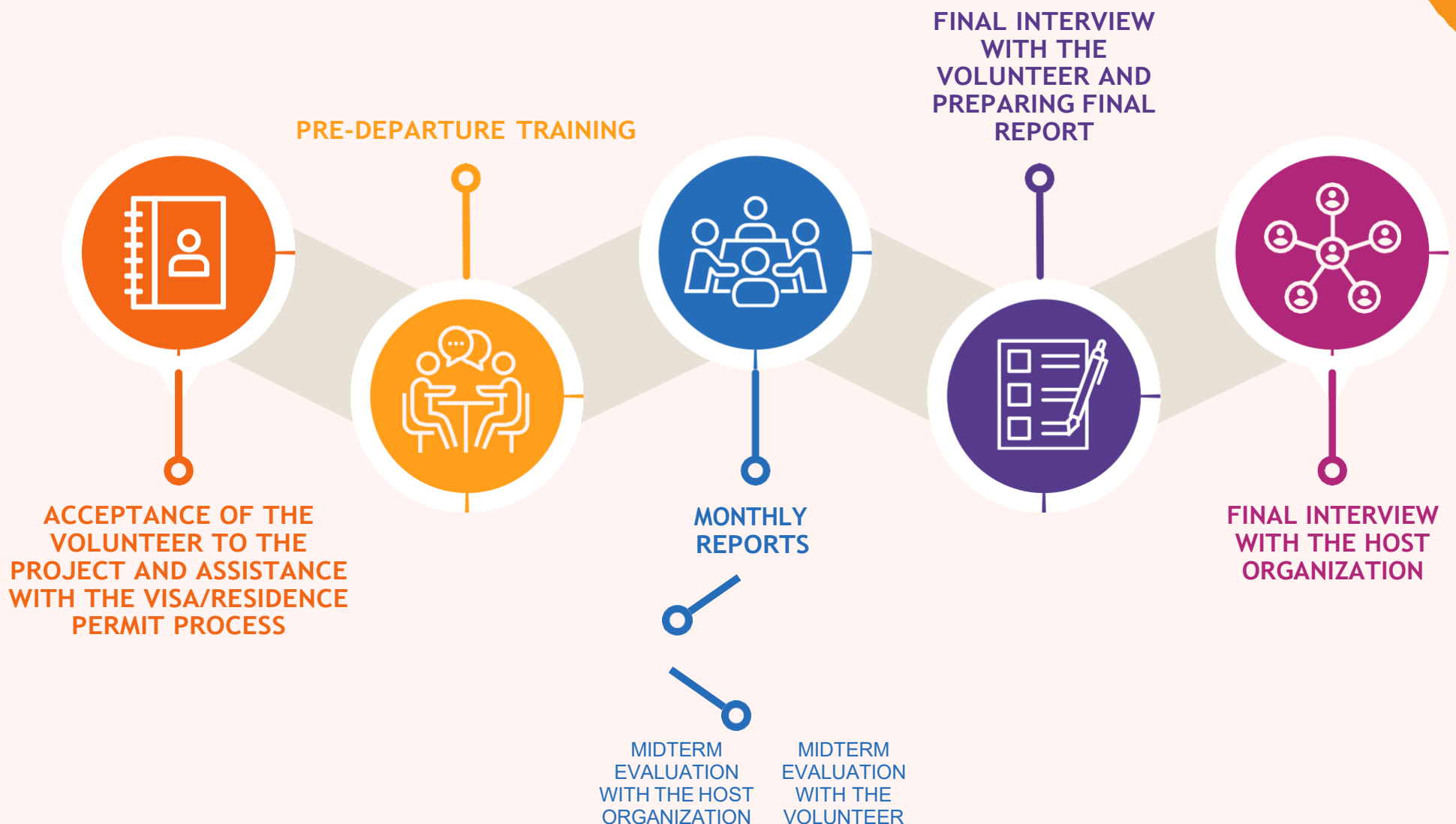

As you can see from the graphic above, after the hosting organization has selected a volunteer:

We hold regular meetings with the hosting organization and our volunteers, from the preparation stage of the project to the closing/reporting process when the project is completed. In addition, we are always open to contact for the urgent needs of you (host organizations) and our volunteers in case of unexpected problems experienced in the project.



Our team supporting our outgoing volunteers consists of 1 General Coordinator, 1 ESC Coordinator, 1 Volunteer Support and 1 Partner Support officer. The responsibilities of these teams are as follows.

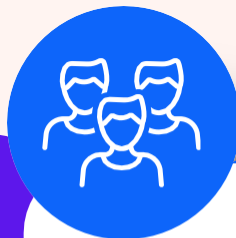

HOW DO WE SUPPORT OUR VOLUNTEERS?

● VOLUNTEER SELECTION PROCESS

During the announcement phase for ESC Volunteer Projects where you are seeking participants, if you share these announcements with us, we disseminate your projects through our communication network, which is followed by a broad youth audience in Türkiye. We forward the documents of individuals who have submitted complete and accurate applications among the received applications to you. This way, you can efficiently select suitable candidates for your project without wasting time on unsuitable or erroneous applications, focusing only on those who are genuinely suitable. This not only saves you time but also prevents you from losing time dealing with intensive questions from potential volunteer candidates.

● VOLUNTEER PREPARATION PROCES

We provide support as a sending organization for volunteers either selected by you through our announcements or directly chosen by you. After you provide us with information about the selected volunteer, we establish a communication bridge between you and the volunteer for the preparation process, assisting both of you by staying in regular contact at all stages, including volunteer agreement, visa procedures, residence permit applications and pre-departure training, ensuring a smooth preparation process.





● **AFTER PROJECT ACTIVITIES BEGIN**

For the volunteers who have started project activities, we monitor their project experiences through monthly evaluation surveys. We gather detailed feedback from the volunteers through interim assessment meetings conducted online at varying intervals based on the project duration. In addition to these supports, while project activities are ongoing, we share photos and blog posts related to the volunteer's activities through our communication channels. At the end of the activity, we send these materials to you as a report for inclusion in your project report.

Beyond all these supports, apart from pre-planned meetings to address potential issues with your volunteers, we can also schedule additional meetings and actively engage in resolving communication problems that may arise.

● **AFTER PROJECT ACTIVITIES CONCLUDE**

Following the completion of the volunteers' activities, we conduct a final evaluation meeting with them. The final evaluation meeting encompasses all monitoring/evaluation efforts and dissemination activities carried out throughout the project and then, you're provided with a comprehensive report. This report serves as a valuable resource for your project reports. In addition to these supports, upon the completion of their activities, we include the volunteers in our "ESC-Alumni" group and continue to inform them about new opportunities in projects, jobs, internships, and volunteering that they can benefit from after ESC projects.

In summary, from the process of identifying the volunteers to the time after their activities are completed, we offer full support to you and the volunteers by sharing all the information we possess in writing as a sending organization. We want to remind you that we provide the same level of support for the volunteers directly selected by you.

We hope to engage in new collaborations with you soon.
